Celebrate me.

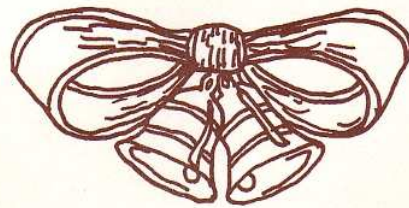


Yes, children love wintering
